

Kaizen Academy Snow Days

Snow and Ice are in the forecast!

When determining whether or not to close the Dojo, our primary goal is safety: In making decisions about closing the dojo for weather we consider local road conditions, parking lot conditions, and the ability for students and instructors to travel safely.

All decisions for whether or not to open the Dojo are made by 2pm the day of the class and if the Dojo is going to be closed, we will send out an email and announce the closure on Facebook.

Our default choice is usually based on the school district plan. We heavily weigh the decisions of the local school districts of Raymond, Deerfield, Nottingham, Northwood, Fremont, Candia and Epping when deciding whether to be open.

If these school districts are closed then it is likely the Dojo will be as well.

If there is a delay or no morning kindergarten, but school is going to be open in the afternoon (or after a 2 hour delay) then the Dojo will likely be open.

If there is an early dismissal due to weather, it is likely the Dojo will be closed.

If some districts are open and others are closed, we will follow Raymond School District as that considers the roads surrounding the dojo.

Saturday special classes: All decisions on Saturday classes will be made by 8am the morning of, and notifications will be on Facebook and sent via email.

If you do not feel comfortable or safe driving, please stay home regardless of whether the dojo is open.

If the Dojo is closed due to inclement weather, or you do not feel safe driving, please feel free to have your student “make up” their missed class at another class time and day available in the following two weeks.
